## **Report by the Mayor of St Blaise Town Council. Councillor June Anderson.**

I was pleased to welcome Adrian Seel back to St Blaise Town Council in October. Councillor Seel served the Council for 22 years prior to leaving us in May 2017 due to health issues. He has so much experience to offer the Council and the residents of the Town.

Dave Pearce, the Community Warden, kept the Town looking good over the summer months and has now started on some winter projects which includes painting the equipment in Trail Blayser Park. This will complete the project to upgrade the park to an acceptable level as it was beginning to look very tired.

As the Polgreaun Development has now started, Dave has had to move his equipment and so we now have a container in the Town Car Park.

I was unable to attend the Remembrance service at St Blazey Church on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November however other Councillors were there and were pleased to see a number of our residents there. I would again like to thank Dave for keeping the memorial clean and tidy.

Councillor Jenny Moore, Chairman of the Neighbourhood Plan Committee, has been working very hard for many months to fit the StARR project into the plan and therefore has had to force back the finish date.

The StARR project is the Environment Agency and Cornwall Council working together on flood amelioration work.

I am pleased to be awarding the Town Council's good citizen award to Betty Hicks this year. This is in recognition of the hard work on the friendship club for people over 60 that is held at St Blazey Football club.

The extension at the Burrows has now been completed with some minor snagging work to be carried out and so I am looking forward to having a grand opening early in the New Year.

We are hopeful that some work is to be carried out at the Britannia Roundabout. St Austell Bay Economic Forum (SABEF) have included the roundabout in their plans for greening St Austell and the Clay Country

It is the entrance to St Blaise Parish and so it needs to be welcoming. The roundabout is effectively the gateway to St Blazey and Par, heading east, and to St Austell heading west, the A390 being the second largest A road in Cornwall.

The current neglected state of the roundabout does not create a favourable impression of this area, or this part of Cornwall. This has become more pressing recently, when it was announced that the Tour of Britain cycle tour will be in the area in September 2020 and passing the roundabout.

I am pleased to say that St Blaise Town Council now has a Waste/Recycling and Climate Change Committee, if you have any ideas how as a Town we could tackle climate change, please let the Clerk know.

We will be putting up the Christmas Trees at St Blazey Church and Leek Seed Chapel ready to welcome attendees of the Carol Concert. This year's Carol Service is to be held at St Blazey Church on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> December at 4.00 pm. I hope to see many of you there.
